SUMMER CAMPAIGN UPDATE

During December and January, SCG Inc conducted a successful campaign to improve public toilet amenities at the Activity Hub adjacent to the ferry wharf. Over 900 postcards were distributed to encourage residents and visitors to voice their dissatisfaction with the state of the current facilities through City of Newcastle (CN).

CN have advised they are now planning an upgrade of the internal and external structural facilities in the 2024/25 Capital Works Program with consideration of improved accessibility as part of the design. Options to improve access to other facilities in Stockton is also being investigated.

This is welcome news! However, we need to continue to voice our ongoing concerns about our public facilities and ensure CN is held accountable for completing planned work.

We would like to thank our SCG Inc members for their work in distributing the postcards and the many local businesses who helped by displaying posters and promoting the campaign. We especially thank the residents and visitors who took the time to contact CN with their concerns.
